

CHEROKEE COUNTY AND CHEROKEE HIGH SCHOOL CODE OF CONDUCT

The Cherokee County School System and Cherokee High School will:

1. Commit to establishing and promoting a positive image of the program, the school and the school system.
2. Adhere to the Cherokee County School System's Discipline Code.
3. Expect that students will not be involved in criminal acts or acts of moral turpitude.
4. Establish team/activity rules.

Violations of the Student Activity Code of Conduct that are verified through a reliable source (school administrator, teacher, coach/sponsor, staff member, parent of involved student, law enforcement agency, etc.) will be investigated thoroughly by Cherokee High School. The violation(s) may result in disciplinary action and/or suspension from extracurricular/interscholastic activities, regardless of whether the offense occurred at a school-related or non-school related activity. Based on the decision of the principal of Cherokee High School (or designee), a participant in extracurricular/interscholastic activities may encounter one or more of the following dispositions for Code of Conduct infractions:

1. Extra practice time, lap time, or other forms of conditioning.
2. Sponsor/student conference.
3. Sponsor/parent conference.
4. Loss of position.
5. Loss of awards privilege.
6. Loss of performance or participation privilege which can include a suspension of part or all of current season, and/or part or all of the next season in which he/she is a participant.
7. Permanent suspension for all extracurricular/interscholastic programs for the remainder of their school year.
8. Cherokee High School reserves the right to permanently dismiss a student from all extracurricular/interscholastic programs for the remainder of their school career upon the arrest or conviction of felony crimes or crimes of moral turpitude.
9. A parent/guardian will be notified of the student's suspension.
10. A suspension report will be filed with the Office of Student Activities and Athletics.

In addition to the above minimum guidelines, students will abide by all standards and guidelines established in the Georgia High School Association Constitution and By-Laws and the Cherokee County Athletic and Activities Handbook.

Students removed, suspended or dismissed from activities because of violations of Cherokee County Discipline Code and/or Local, State, or Federal Laws, will not regain eligibility by transferring to another Cherokee County School.
